

Support Local Shop Local – Terms and Conditions

Hurley’s Media and Cayman National have teamed up for “Support Local Shop Local”. When patrons spend \$10 or more at a participating shop, they will receive one entry into the competition.

1. A purchase of \$10 or more has to be made at one of the participating shops.
2. Only one entry will be accepted per person, per day. Multiple entries from the same person on the same day will be disqualified.
3. The competition will run June 15th – September 11th 2020.
4. After September 11th, 2020 there is no further entries to the competition permitted.
5. The rules of the competition and how to enter are as follows:
 - a. Make a purchase of \$10 or more at any participating shop.
 - b. Fill out an entry card with your contact information.
 - c. Drop the entry card into the box.
6. The competition is open to any person living in the Cayman Islands that makes a purchase of \$10 or more at a participating store.
7. You must stay within the terms of the Cayman Islands Shelter in Place curfew.
8. Entrants are not permitted to purchase entries. If the promoter believes this may have occurred, they will be disqualified from winning the competition.
9. The prize cannot be exchanged for cash and is not transferable.
10. The winners will be announced live on the radio, after the competition close date.
11. The winners will be notified by way of contact information received from the entry card within 2 days of the closing date. If the winner cannot be contacted or do not claim the prize within 30 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.
12. The promoter will notify the winner when and where the prize can be collected or is delivered.
13. The winner agrees to the use of his/her name and image in any publicity material, as well as their entry.
14. The promoter reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter’s control. The promoter will notify any changes to the competition to entrants as soon as possible.
